# **THINK DATA FOREWORD BRIDGING THE DATA GAP**

### Glocal Toppers Make Prime Video Shine and Stand Out.

One of the classic marketing rules is called "duality." It suggests that in any category, there's space for only two brands: a leader and a runner-up, often competing on price. For years, marketing literature has brimmed with case studies like Coca-Cola vs. Pepsi or McDonald's vs. Burger King. However, the challenge with the ongoing streaming wars lies in Amazon's apparent indifference, as it seems unlikely that Prime Video is believing its second place. Is the E-commerce giant beginning to move in that direction?

Traditionally, one of the most common strategies for a secondary brand in a category has been to emulate the leader and, in doing so, surpass it. Prime Video is adopting a similar approach by embracing the Glocal content strategy that has propelled Netflix to stardom. Glocal content is at the core of building a vital link between independent industries and streaming platforms, distinguishing the latter from industry majors.

Month after month, non-American productions are making significant headway in the streaming landscape. While some months present greater challenges than others, European, Asian, and Latin American production powerhouses consistently claim top positions with a diverse range of series and films spanning various genres. The month of June shows that non-American content is growing and is here to stay.

Through titles such as "Culpa Mia", "Medellin" and "The Covenant" Amazon underscores its relevance in this month's streaming wars. Simultaneously, Prime Video has surged in figures and market share with a Spanish Wattpad romance, a French Action-Comedy filmed in Colombia, and a Guy Ritchie film set in Afghanistan. These titles have earned Prime Video top positions, ranking 1st and 2nd in various markets. All three titles are spotlighted as Hot Titles in this report, each accompanied by compelling backstories that provide insight into forthcoming developments.

Hence, Amazon has grasped the intricacies of the Glocal game, and as these titles pave the way for many more, we anticipate witnessing their expansion. However, a question arises: if the duality rule accommodates only two brands per category, what lies ahead for MAX and DISNEY+? Do they perceive themselves as contenders for the runner-up position? Have they embarked on an ambitious Glocal content strategy? Answers may unfold in the forthcoming months.

### WHAT IS SODA How we do what we do...

In 2019, Digital i developed SoDA, our new SVOD viewing measurement system, starting with the biggest SVOD service in the world, Netflix. In 2020 we built upon the success of the project by launching measurement of Amazon Prime Video.

Much like TV audience measurement systems across the world, SoDA is a sample based system, however, our methodology is unique in the sense that it collects accurate viewing data that comes directly from the accounts of a fully managed panel.

The data we use is passively collected, meaning zero human error. Our methodology also means that we capture viewing across all devices (including the TV set) and also viewing to content that is recorded and viewed offline. We are currently collecting this data from a sample of over 6250 accounts, this data is then processed through our system and weights are applied to make the viewing data representative of the subscriber bases in each territory. Our sampling methodologies hove been verified by leading statisticians and are statistically robust.

The data allows us to interrogate SVOD viewing in great detail, including analysing total consumption, the lifecycle of content, binge viewing, series loyalty and much more.

The data is available through our online dashboard system which allows users to login and directly access and interrogate SVOD data with unprecedented flexibility.

The data is available in the following territories - UK, France, Germany, Spain and Italy.

### **CHURN WARS**

Let's not just blame it on the good weather. This year, macroeconomic conditions also play a significant role in this erratic relationship that users seem to have with screens when the heat sets in.

The streaming war is weaving a narrative full of unexpected twists. What appeared to be a thriving market with ample room ahead has transformed into treacherous terrain marked by volatility.


Subscriber figures, starting from last year, tell the tale of the unstable health of a platform. The variability in service penetration numbers during hours of content played month by month also illustrates this.

Now, original programming faces a challenge beyond capturing the attention of its potential audience: it needs to cope with the inconsistency of platform users in maintaining their subscriptions, with many potentially not having subscriptions at the time of release.

Maintaining an attractive and diverse catalog is not within the reach of all players currently operating in the sector. For more indebted companies like Warner Bros Discovery (owner of HBO Max) or Disney+, the new roadmap is laden with canceled projects, content removed from the catalog, and a significant increase in third-party licensing. Who benefits the most? Netflix and Prime, still possessing financial leeway to invest heavily in project development, are profiting from the reactivation of the licensing market.

This not only helps diversify their offerings with highly demanded catalog content (recall the "Suits" phenomenon on Netflix USA) but also strengthens their service against the erosion that the writers' and actors' strike will cause in releases in the last stretch of this year and the first half of the coming year.

It is highly likely that catalog content (especially of English origin) will increase its presence in European rankings over the next months, even in countries where the traditionally strong local content has been a significant stream generator. Platforms seem willing to concede this ground because the winning hand in engagement currently belongs to services willing to offer a lot of everything.






#### **CATALOG SHARE BY COUNTRY**


#### WHEN THE HEAT COMES, SPANISH **RECLAIMS ITS STREAMS**


#### **OLD HABITS DIE HARD: ACTION STILL RULES IN THE SUMMERTIME**

Last month, we were already observing a certain surge in the Action genre on various platforms. Now, with the official arrival of summer, the Action genre, as has been the trend in previous years, is soaring. Capturing an impressive 37.8% share, this genre proudly claims the top spot for viewership this month. Titles like "Extraction 2", "Extraction", "Escape Room 2" and "The Covenant" are contributing to this surge. Additionally, it's worth noting the growth of the Animation genre, which holds a 13.2% share, securing its position as the fourth most-watched genre. It's giving tough competition to Drama, primarily fueled by summer blockbuster classics like "Spider-Man: Into the Spider-Verse".




### YA LOCAL ROMANCE TRIUMPHS

Diving into the realm of YA Romance seems almost instinctive during the summer months, a season replete with escapism, outdoor allure, date night possibilities, and ample leisure hours. And Spain has been mastering this craft with impressive finesse. "A través del mar" (1.9M) and its predecessor "Through My Window" (689K), alongside "Culpa Mía", have emerged as the pivotal trio captivating local screens this June. Collectively, local streaming titles have proudly claimed 13.7% of the streaming share—a commendable feat.


#### **EUROPEAN PRODUCTIONS FLOURISH**


Europe, boasting a share of 14.7%, surprises by slightly edging past the local dominance by a mere point. Titles such as "Extraction 2", "A Beautiful Life", "Blood and Gold", and "Medellin", among a plethora of others, have contributed to this surge. This percentage notably approaches the golden figures witnessed back in November and December 2022, periods marked by a conspicuous upsurge in European productions.





PRODUCTION COUNTRIES: Europe Spain Others







#### **MOST WATCHED GENRES** SHARE BY PLATFORM


**TOTAL STREAMS BY GENRES** PLATFORM COMPARATIVE

#### AMAZON'S RESURGENCE CONTENT MIX AMIDST ENTRANTS

Amazon has successfully reclaimed its previous share percentages, reminiscent of times before the entry of Disney+ and HBO Max into the streaming arena, boasting a notable 19.6% share—an impressively substantial figure. HBO Max, while experiencing a slight dip in its share, sees a marginal recovery for Disney+, resulting in a combined 15% share for the two platforms.

Despite a minor share loss, HBO Max has achieved a significant milestone by securing positions for European films in the top #100 most-watched movies this month, featuring titles like "Evil Dead Rise" and "Mom or Dad?". Disney, on the other hand, has managed to place only "Luca" within this echelon. Notably, Amazon's efforts this month predominantly revolve around the inclusion of local productions, including the previously mentioned "Culpa Mía", "Voy a pasármelo bien", "Padre no hay más que uno 3", and "¡A todo tren!"




### **CATALOG SHARE BY COUNTRY**


#### LOCAL AUDIENCES PUT UP WITH **GOOD WEATHER**


In contrast to other markets, Spain, along with Italy, has managed to maintain the number of streams accumulated in its Top #100 this month. This is noteworthy despite Spain experiencing a steep decline in streaming numbers since January of this year, following the introduction of password-sharing policies.

#### LIĽ REVIVAL OF LATAM A PRODUCTIONS

This year, Latin American productions are regaining momentum after a few subdued months. In the first quarter of 2022, the Latin American series achieved impressive success, consistently holding no less than a 20% share. Subsequently, their presence in the charts has gradually waned, hitting its lowest point during the first quarter of 2023, plummeting to 4.45%. However, this month, there has been a slight recovery, reaching 7.15% share, propelled by the popularity of "Fake Profile", produced by Paramount Television International Studios for Netflix, and "The Surrogacy".











#### **"VALERIA", "THE PLAYING CARD KILLER" AND "CITES" RULE THE CHARTS**

This month, undoubtedly, the spotlight is on "Valeria". The arrival of its third season marked the beginning of June with high anticipation in Spain, solidifying its position as one of the highlighted summer releases. "Valeria" has been, since its inception, one of the most-watched Spanish series both domestically and internationally. In Spain alone, this third season has garnered nearly 29M streams, while in other markets, it reached 45.7M streams. Since the series' debut, our data reveals that it has accumulated 107M streams, making it the fifth most-watched Spanish series in our available dataset.


Another significant release this month is "The Playing Card Killer," a three-episode non-fiction mini-series that delves into the narrative of the serial killer who instilled fear in Madrid back in 2003, achieving 3.8M streams. This isn't the first production focused on this serial killer this year. The initial one premiered early in the year on RTVE Play.

On a different note, the Catalan production "Cites" has garnered 3.6M streams this month, rapidly becoming the most-watched series on Amazon in the Spanish market. It also ranks fourth in Amazon's top-viewed series this year, following "El Pueblo", "La que se avecina" and "Sin Huellas". The series is a collaborative effort between Prime Video and TV3.



### **MOST WATCHED GENRES**


SHARE BY PLATFORM

#### NETFLIX'S RESURGENCE AND HBO MAX'S SETBACK

Netflix made a noticeable recovery in terms of share, reaching 65.5%, and has regained its position and leadership since the introduction of Disney+ to the charts last April. Interestingly, Disney+ also makes a substantial gain, nearly regaining 10 points in comparison to the previous month. This surge is primarily attributed to the popularity of "Bluey", "How I Met Your Mother" and "Futurama" with "Bluey" being the primary contributor, accounting for 23.4M streams.

On the flip side, HBO Max experienced a significant loss of over 12% in share, dwindling down to just 8.12%. This downturn highlights the impact of "The Idol" and, to a lesser extent, other shows that haven't resonated as strongly for the platform. These TV shows, unlike the previous hits such as "Succession", "House of Dragons" or "The White Lotus" seem to have struggled to maintain the platform's previous momentum.

### **HOT CONTENT IN SPAIN** "CULPA MÍA" AND "A TRAVÉS DEL MAR": SPANISH PRODUCTIONS THAT GO FROM WATTPAD TO WORLDWIDE SCREENS

In recent years, Spain has undeniably mastered the realm of Young Adult (YA) fiction, particularly within the domain of YA romance. This month, Amazon has once again ventured into the territory of intricate teenage love with the release of "Culpa Mía" adding another successful ingredient to the mix: prestigious Intellectual Properties (IPs) from Wattpad. This gamble has undoubtedly paid off, reaffirming one of the primary insights extracted from the second Think Data Equinox report: young content frequently flourishes when built upon existing IPs.

Produced in Spain by Pokeepsie Films, led by Álex de la Iglesia and Carolina Bang, this inaugural instalment adapts the literary trilogy "Culpables". Originating as a Wattpad novel in 2017 when the series garnered over 75M reads on the platform. The story, brimming with unbridled passion and forbidden love, has rapidly ascended to prominence. According to platform reports, the film has secured its place among the top 10 most-watched titles in over 190 countries, encompassing the US, the UK, Australia, India, Argentina, and France. Within these reports, "Culpa Mía" stands as Amazon Prime Video's most-viewed movie across global markets for the month, amassing a staggering 5.4M views, and ranking fourth among the most popular films of 2023.

Amazon Prime Video confirmed two additional films to complete the Mercedes Ron's book trilogy "Culpa Tuya" and "Culpa Nuestra", continuing the romantic drama storyline. This trajectory mirrors the successful pattern of the "Through the Window" saga, a series that falls just short of "Culpa Mía" in terms of streams, with slightly under 1M streams and a total of 6.2M across all markets.

In this regard, Amazon Prime Video's recent strategy appears to encroach on the territory pioneered by Netflix. By revisiting formulas that have proven successful for the streaming giant, "Culpa Mía" closely follows the path not only of "Through the Window" but also of Netflix's "Purple Hearts", "The Royal Treatment", "The Girl Allergic to Wifi" and "The Kissing Booth" among others.

Shifting our attention to another title ignited by Wattpad, we can also showcase "A Través del Mar". Following the original film's triumph as one of the most successful non-English language releases on the platform, the streaming giant continues to bet on the success of this IP. "A través del Mar" now captures the ambience of the Costa Brava, with its picturesque steps, coves, and ice cream delights. The production is helmed by Nostromo Pictures, a production house that has once again struck gold in the streaming landscape after "Los Renglones Torcidos de LOLA RODRÍGUEZ DATA SPECIALIST



Dios." Notably, Nostromo Pictures doesn't seem tied to a single streaming company, a strategy that has also proven successful for studios like Zeta Studios.

As the world witnesses the rise of Spanish-made young adult content, it's evident that the seamless fusion of Wattpad's IPs and captivating storytelling has empowered Spain to dominate the realm of YA romance, with "Culpa Mía" standing as the latest testament to this narrative prowess.






#### SHIFTS AND SETBACKS: ITALY COMES BACK AS THE SMALLEST MARKET OF ALL


After four months of continuous growth that led them to surpass the Spanish and German markets in volume, the Italian market has experienced a setback, relinquishing all the accumulated streams it had gradually amassed over these months. Presently, as the smallest market among the five, Italy aggregates 36 million streams within its Top 100. Fortunately, the American market has borne the brunt of this impact, accounting for only 45% of the Top, despite possessing over 50% of the content catalogue.

#### THIS MONTH IN TODAY'S MENU: **COMMEDIA ALL ITALIANA**

The record for the month where streams were higher for Italian comedy was achieved in April, with 9.8M views. Nonetheless, Italy has steadfastly maintained its local Comedy streams at the forefront. This month, Italian Comedy remains unequivocally the most-watched genre, amassing 6M streams. From the inception of this report, it was evident that Comedy played a central role in the Italian market, yet what continues to astonish us to this day is its unrelenting ability to keep growing. This month, this phenomenon is exemplified by movies such as "La Straordinaria Scorperta", "Il Grande Giorno", "The First Day of My Life" and "Me Contro Te - Il Mistero della Scuola Incantata" among others.






#### WONDERFUL MONTH FOR EUROPEAN PRODUCTIONS

An occurrence that has been absent for quite some time has surfaced in the Italian market: the majority of the Top 5 positions are now occupied by European productions. Taking the top spot is "Extraction 2" followed by "A Beautiful Life" and "A través del mar". "Extraction 2" and "A través del Mar" are a sequel to respectively the 2020 film "Extraction" and ""Through My Window". "A Beautiful Life" is a 2023 Danish drama romance musical film directed by Mehdi Avaz and featuring Christopher Lund Nissen, a very popular Danish singer.

On the other hand, "Mixed By Erry" or "La Straordinaria Scoperta", the local film directed by Sydney Sibilia that has captivated audiences (968K) with its unique portrayal of the real-life story of the Frattasio siblings and their ventures in the compilation business.


In total, a notable number of 32 local films have made their entry into the general Top 100 rankings. This translates to nearly one-third of this month's films being of European origin—a truly heartening revelation. Consequently, European productions, inclusive of those from the UK, have achieved an equally impressive share as their American and Canadian counterparts, securing 45% of the share. This development serves as a fantastic piece of news to kickstart the summer season.

PRODUCTION COUNTRIES: Europe Italy Others






#### **NETFLIX FACES ITS WORST MONTH IN** ITALY, WHILE DISNEY + AND AMAZON SHINÉ

After three months on our reports, Disney+ remains absent from the top European film rankings this month in Italy. The platform has made some incremental gains, although it is Amazon, boosted by titles like "Culpa Mía" and "Il Grande Giorno", the platform that has grown the most. Disney+ and Prime have secured, respectively 18.4% and 23% of the total share.

The spotlight of the analysis rests on Netflix, which commands a dominant 58.5% share this month—remarkably, but still the lowest observed for the Italian market.


#### **ITALY RESISTS WITHOUT RELYING TOO MUCH ON AMERICAN CONTENT**

As discussed in the previous report, the Italian market is undergoing a gradual yet potent development and growth. This month, despite a minor decrease in streams compared to the previous one, the Top #100 manages to sustain and slightly decline from the momentum achieved so far. Remarkably, this happens even during a month when both the film and series markets have experienced a general downward trend in the other markets. Encouragingly, consumption hasn't been primarily driven or maintained by American content, although the most-watched productions like "Never Have I Ever", "How I Met Your Mother" and "Grey's Anatomy" are of American origin.

#### ACTION AND ANIMATION GROW SIGNIFICANTLY

This month, there is some prominence in the Animation genre, which has nearly quadrupled to almost 19% compared to the previous month, thanks in large part to "This World Can't Tear Me Down" (21.5M) and "Grizzy and the Lemmings" (5.5M). The Action genre, at 7.5%, also stands out this month. Although not as prevalent in the series market, this genre tends to thrive, particularly during the summer. However, comedy takes the spotlight this month, with a total of 118M streams. Oh! And something that happens once in a blue moon happened: local productions in the comedy genre aren't as dominant this month.


Italian streaming platforms have seen a resurgence, largely attributed to the success of two local shows: "This World Can't Tear Me Down" and "Pesci piccoli - Un'agenzia, molte idee, poco budget". Collectively, these shows have contributed to 12.7% of the total streams, marking a commendable recovery from the slump witnessed in the previous months.


"This World Can't Tear Me Down" emerges as the local leader, capitalising on "Tear Along the Dotted Line" characters. Authored and directed by the Italian cartoonist Zerocalcare, the series made its debut on October 18th at the prestigious Rome Film Fest. The anticipation for the show was palpable, as evidenced by the release of its first animated series trailer on February 9, 2023, during the seventy-third Sanremo Festival on Rai

A collaborative effort between The Jackal and Mad Entertainment in conjunction with Prime Video, "Pesci piccoli - Un'agenzia, molte idee, poco budget" has emerged as a resounding success. The show has achieved a remarkable milestone, amassing a staggering 9.6M viewers and getting to the second most popular project of 2023 for Amazon so far.











### **MOST WATCHED GENRES**




#### LOCAL CARTOONIST TAKES NETFLIX **ON A MEMORY LANE TRIP AND BREAKS OUT OF ITS FEEL-GOOD COMFORT** ZONE

Disney continues to amass streams relentlessly in a market where it reigns supreme. With a commanding share of almost 38% of the total streams, Disney+ asserts its dominance as the unrivalled leader. Notably, in the Italian market, Disney+ operates with a significant advantage over its competitors.

On a different note, Amazon maintains a similar position to the previous month, securing a 10.8% share of the total streams, primarily focusing on specific genres such as Comedy and Documentary content. Meanwhile, Netflix experiences a marginal decline, although by less than two decimal points.





### **HOT CONTENT IN ITALY** Local cartoonist takes netflix on a memory lane trip and breaks out of its feel-good comfort zone

"This World Can't Tear Me Down" originally known as "Questo mondo non mi renderà cattivo" is undoubtedly a remarkable Italian production. With 21.5 million views in its local market and ranking as the fourth biggest introduction for a local show, this adult animated series, crafted by the renowned cartoonist Zerocalcare who undertook both writing and directorial roles, stands as a bold testament to Netflix Italy's dedication to creating content that harkens back to its creative origins, reminiscent of iconic works such as "Bojack Horseman".

But what is the connection between "This World Can't Tear Me Down" and this dedication? The first hint can be found in the creator's initial Netflix project, "Tear Along the Dotted Line" where Zerocalcare grapples with his own anxiety, personified by a conversing armadillo. This parallel extends to the incorporation of anthropomorphic animals and birds, each embodying distinct personality traits and belief systems, enriching the narrative simultaneously – animals, anxiety, and art ... Do you all get it, right?

However, the most significant aspect that draws parallels to "Bojack Horseman" is the show's embrace of complexity. Much like the early days of Los Gatos' trajectory, this series engages in producing a complex narrative without necessarily providing a comforting or happy perspective. "Tear World Can't Tear Me Down" evokes the spirit of "Bojack Horseman", perhaps one of the most critically acclaimed Netflix Originals. What fascinates us more about the success of the show is precisely that Netflix is still inclined to create content like this. Because Bojack entered our lives in a very different time, where profit and success meant something else for Netflix. We can't help but wonder to ourselves: Would "Bojack Horseman" have survived more than one season if pitched and produced now? We don't really know the answer, but we know "This World Can't Tear Me Down" has.

However, the series goes beyond that. "This World Can't Tear Me Down" takes a bolder route by directly confronting the resurgence of fascism on European streets, particularly within Italy's societal fabric. Getting straight to the point, it presents an unfiltered depiction of the nation's intricate socio-political landscape. Departing from conventional explorations that attribute neo-fascism to upbringing and external influences, the series refrains from making excuses. Instead, it embarks on a journey to navigate the intricate dynamics using a blend of entertainment and humor, providing an alternative lens to comprehend these multifaceted societal challenges without adhering to strict political correctness. 





#### FRENCH MARKET ALSO EXPERIENCES **A DECLINE**

From December 2022, the total number of streams in the Top #10 has been taking a nosedive - dropping from a whopping 75M streams down to 52 million in just seven months. It is pertinent to note, however, that despite this decline, the French market has managed to retain its relative standing vis-à-vis other markets, steadfastly securing its position as the second largest among the five compared.

#### ACTION AND ANIMATION STEAL TOGETHER ALMOST HALF OF STREAMS

The prominent role assumed by Action-oriented films is noteworthy. The genre has emerged as a veritable centrepiece, boasting an impressive surge that has culminated in a significant 34% share. This trend can be attributed to titles such as "Extraction 2", "Birds of Prey", "Extraction", "Blood and Gold", and also the French "Medellin" (categorised as Comedy but having a lot of Action). Animations have also made a wicked comeback, clocking in at 14% of the pie. Movies like "Wonder Park," a Spanish-American coproduction, and "Black Cover: Sword of the Wizard King," a Japanese piece, are surely stirring up the buzz.





#### **EUROPEAN PRODUCTIONS GET THEIR HIGHEST SHARE IN FRANCE**

The cumulative share of European movies reaches a notable 16.75%, marking the highest quantity of European streams ever attained in the French market since the commencement of available data. This is indeed wonderful news. Notable titles contributing to this achievement include the Czech film "Extraction 2" the Spanish film "A través del mar", the Danish film "A Beautiful Life" as well as the Spanish production "Culpa Mía," among others.

In contrast, June is one of the months in which local productions have garnered a lower share, especially when compared to the performance local films were exhibiting in 2023. During this year, local films are maintaining an average share of 20%. The only local movie that we observe making its way into the general Top #25 and securing the #2 spot for European films is Franck Gastambide's "Medellin" a Comedy-Action Amazon Original that's adequately balanced with dark humour and exhilarating action sequences, featuring commendable acting from a well-recognized cast. Check our French hot title to discover all the backstory of "Medellin".






### **MOST WATCHED GENRES**



#### LOCAL AMAZON FLICKS SHINE WHILE NETFLIX SEES DECLINE

Without significantly altering the trend from previous months, Amazon and Disney+ continue to hold the second and third positions with 15.4% and 10.2% shares, respectively. The standout performer this month, without a doubt, is "Medellin," an Amazon France production that has managed to amass 4.8 million views across all markets. While in any other month, it would undoubtedly have claimed the title of the most-watched film, this month the crown goes to "Culpa Mía" with 5.4 million views, ultimately contributing to an exceptionally favourable month for Amazon Prime.

Netflix is the platform that's mainly experiencing the decline in streams mentioned earlier, shedding nearly 6 million streams compared to the previous month and a total of 29 million streams since December 2022.





After a robust three-month period of heightened consumption during spring, the onset of summer has witnessed a decline in viewership, mirroring trends observed in the British and German markets.


#### LATAM STAYS IN FRANCE


LATAM content is undoubtedly intriguing for French audiences who are in search of novel and distinct entertainment options. The market consistently showcases LATAM content, often featuring a highlight almost every month. This month, the spotlight has fallen on the Colombian original series "Fake Profile" (16.2M), which has emerged as an unexpected streaming success this summer. The series has secured a place in Netflix's Top 10 list on both sides of the Atlantic, garnering a remarkable viewership. According to our reports, the show has amassed a total of 41.5M views across our markets.

#### **ASIAN CONTENT SHINES ON TOP #15**

In France, the majority of content originates from the USA and Canada. However, this dominance is occasionally punctuated by the inclusion of two Asian series. One example is the enduringly popular "Naruto: Shippûden," a series that consistently features prominently in Think Data reports in France, particularly coinciding with holidays. Since the availability of data, the series has accumulated an impressive 434 million streams, underscoring its enduring popularity among French viewers. Another noteworthy inclusion is "Bloodhounds" (7.1M), a series inspired by a well-received webtoon or webcomic released in 2022.








#### PRODUCTIONS LOCAL **SLIGHTLY** BELOW PERFORMANCE

A notable player in the streaming arena is "Les Sisters," a show that continues to steadily accumulate streams. Its outstanding performance makes it the third most-viewed show within its local market, boasting an impressive viewership of 79.8M since we have data. Conversely, the recently unveiled season of "Rhythm + Flow France" has garnered significant attention, amassing a viewership of 20 million for its second season alone. Another prominent contender is "Vortex," a Franco-Belgian television miniseries that stands as a remarkable exemplar of international collaboration. This co-production involving Quad Drama, AT-Production, and RTBF (Belgian television) is designed for France 2. Its creation has been bolstered by support from the Brittany and Île-de-France regions, as well as the participation of RTS (Swiss television). The series has impressively garnered close to 4M views. This is another example of the rather new synergies between linear TV and streamers, that we have observed in the Galic country.

Shifting to the European landscape, "Valeria" has emerged as a prominent fixture throughout this month's streaming panorama. Despite its notable popularity, the show currently occupies the #16 position on the general streaming list.




#### **DISNEY**<sup>±</sup> **DECREASES 8 POINTS THIS** MONTH

The aforementioned decline in consumption has notably impacted Disney+, which experienced a significant decrease of 8 percentage points compared to the previous month. This decline has resulted in Disney+ accounting for only 20.5% of the total streams for this period. The two mostviewed series this month are "Bluey" and "The Simpsons."

In contrast, Amazon has demonstrated a slight resurgence, capturing a 4.3% share of the total streams. For Amazon, "The Mentalist" emerges as the most popular show during this period. Its second most popular show has been "The Summer I Turned Pretty", positioned at #45.







### HOT CONTENT IN FRANCE **MEDELLIN: OR HOW AMAZON PRIME ALSO SUCCEEDS WITH GASTAMBIDE.**

In the past year, we've dedicated a few Hot Titles to the analysis of Action movies in France. We notably featured "Athena" and "Restless" as representative titles of the French Action wave. "Restless" is a film starring Franck Gastambide, a former dog trainer who had the chance to meet Mathieu Kassovitz in the nineties and escalated from there as a producer and director of blockbusters like the "Taxi" franchise and "Pattaya". While there was a time when Europa Corp and Luc Besson reigned in that tradition, the 2000s saw a decline in the genre's presence in the theatrical window. However, Netflix changed the game by opening its local office in 2020 and crafting an ambitious local Action slate, including titles like "Restless", "Lost Bullet", "Braqueurs", "Sentinelle", "Earth and Blood", and "The Takedown", along with series like "The 7 Lives of Lea" and "Bendo".

At that time, Sara May, Netflix Originals Director for France, commented to Variety that "Since the 'Taxi' franchise, whose first film came out nearly 20 years ago, there hadn't been a big French-language action franchise... we had tapped into a real need with 'Lost Bullet'," continued May, who admitted to having "a soft spot for action movies".

Today, the male, young, and action-driven audience is hooked on VOD and craves even more Action content. Consequently, other platforms are now capitalising on this trend. Canal+ also recently leveraged Gastambide's magic with the rapper series "Validé", which achieved great numbers in France and garnered significant social media awareness. Following suit,

**44** Amazon's French Originals Director, Thomas Dubois, also enlisted Gastambide (Mandarin **Productions) for "Medellin", the most** ambitious film in Prime Video's French slate to date.

Unsurprisingly, "Medellin" made a splash, reaching the second position this month, only a few streams behind the Czech Action film "Extraction 2", and amassing 2.3 million streams in France. Additionally, no other French title held a significant presence on the June grid, certainly not from Netflix. This success is a major victory for Prime Video, which often grapples to secure top titles and maintain its share in France. Although the film didn't achieve resounding success in other analysed markets, it still claimed high positions with 780K streams in Spain, 610K in Germany, and 500K in Italy. However, it generated much less interest in the UK (despite being partially English-speaking), where it reached only 200K streams, placing it at number 28.

Franck Gastambide is not only a significant money-maker but also a cultural symbol for content that isn't necessarily intellectual or high-brow in France. Many of his films are set in the outskirts and adopt a genuine approach to portraying diverse characters. However, Gastambide often incorporates clichés, and "Medellin" is no exception. Although the Cartel de Medellin ceased to exist in its original form for two decades, Gastambide resurrects its violence in the present day and intertwines it with influencer culture. Despite lacking historical accuracy, in terms of cinematic formulas, we must acknowledge its genius. Taking a broader perspective on this particular success, Prime Video's recent strategy encroaches on Netflix's territory by SARAH CALDERÓN



revisiting formulas that have proven successful for the streaming giant. While this strategy may not be coincidental, it is a consistent approach often employed by secondary market leaders. Notably, this month, "Medellin" shares the stage with "Culpa Mia", Amazon's Wattpad adaptation by the same writer as "Through My Window", a previous major hit on Netflix. "Culpa Mia" achieved a top 7 position in France and found success in other territories, as mentioned in our Spanish Hot Title of the month.




#### MORE THAN 60% OF STREAMS COME FROM FAMILY & KIDS & ACTION





#### **UK BREAKS A GLOBAL RECORD**

When combined with the streams from other genres, the UK accumulates 37.7% of the total streams, marking the highest relative percentage ever recorded not only for the UK but also across all markets in this report. This can be attributed partly to the decrease in views of American content, which only accounts for 44.7% of the total streams this month.

#### EUROPEAN FILMS SURPASS **EXPECTATIONS: RECORD STREAMS** AND MARKET IMPACT IN THE UK


European movies have achieved their secondhighest number of streams in the Top #100, along with their highest relative percentage this month, totalling 5.3 million streams and accounting for 8.9%. This is primarily due to the Czech-American co-production 'Extraction 2,' the French film 'The Family,' the Danish production 'A Beautiful Life,' and the Spanish movie "Culpa Mía", among others. When combined with local streams, films from the Old Continent capture 53% of the total streams, surpassing streams from the USA & Canada for the very first time in the UK market. 




#### **BRITISH STREAMERS MONTH OF UPS** AND DOWNS











#### ONLY LOCAL PRODUCTIONS IN THE **EUROPEAN CHARTS**

Not a single European series has managed to secure a spot in the Top #100 for this month, echoing a trend observed earlier in the first quarter of the year. However, the landscape does feature local productions - a total of 7, to be exact - which collectively hold a 9.55% share.

"Black Mirror" made its mark in September 2015 when Netflix acquired the series' rights. To date, the show boasts 6 seasons. The latest season, which premiered in June, has garnered 17.4M views in this market and nearly 54M across all markets. Another crime documentary series, "When Missing Turns to Murder," has accumulated 2.6M views. "The Full Monty," the series that follows up on the 1997 film of the same name, has achieved 3.3M streams. Lastly, "Cunk on Earth," the sole Amazon product to enter the European charts, is a mockumentary that premiered on BBC Two in the United Kingdom. It has since found a home on Netflix, amassing 2.6M views.










### MOST WATCHED GENRES




#### ALL THREE PLATFORMS EXPERIENCED A DECLINE


The decline in consumption within the English market has manifested as a result of a collective downturn across all three platforms. In absolute terms, the most substantial decrease has been observed in Netflix's performance, which experienced a decline of up to 60K viewers in its Top 100 within just one month.

It's worth highlighting that this month, the British market has positioned itself as an arena where Amazon wields lesser influence within the Top #100 ranking. In the current period, the platform has only managed to secure a presence for three titles on our lists. The first Amazon show doesn't appear until the 40th position out of 55. The second spot for the platform, "The Grand Tour," is a locally produced content piece.

### **HOT CONTENT IN UK GUY RITCHIE: OR HOW TO REPURPOSE AS A BLOCKBUSTER STREAMING DIRECTOR**

Back in 2000, Guy Ritchie was an independent icon. His films "Snatch" and "Lock & Stock" marked a generation and crossed over to reach broad audiences theatrically. However, as we trace his life timeline, the newest titles are quite the opposite: "Aladdin", "Sherlock Holmes" and "King Arthur" are just a few of the existing IP blockbusters that he shifted towards.

In 2023, Guy Ritchie released two films: "The Covenant" starring Jake Gyllenhaal, and "Operation Fortune". The US producer and sales agent STX initiated both projects. The Wrap reported in January 2022

**44** "The Covenant" was sold to MGM and Amazon even before the streamer acquired MGM. While MGM retained the US theatrical rights, Amazon secured most of the international rights, paying half of the film's budget.

With a total budget of 55M, Amazon's payment was 28M. The film saw theatrical releases in hand-picked territories, including the US (grossing 21M USD at the box office). Due to Prime Video holding the non-US rights, the film went directly to VOD in the UK, the director's home territory—a move both surprising and indicative of the current times. A third party, a Russian streaming service, was involved in the writing and creative process and retained Russian theatrical rights, where the film grossed over 3M at the box office.

Although the box office figures were lacklustre, this situation bodes well for Amazon, which is capitalising on its strategic deal with MGM. This trend is expected to continue, as both MGM and Amazon announced a promising lineup of remakes last April. As reported by <u>Binged</u>, the 2023 slate is steeped in nostalgia, predominantly revisiting MGM's existing IPs to the point of exhaustion, including films and series like "Legally Blonde", "Robocop", "Pink Panther", "The Magnificent SARAH CALDERÓN

According to <u>Screenrant</u>, "Ritchie's filmography has made almost \$3 billion at the worldwide box office, but the filmmaker has had two bad bombs in quick succession. Ritchie is undoubtedly a prolific director, but working at such a pace didn't go in his favour this time. "The Covenant" has gotten overwhelmingly positive reviews, but it's different from what critics and audiences have come to expect from the director, and that has resulted in a shockingly low box office gross. And just one month earlier, "Operation Fortune" had a disappointing performance too, failing to make back its budget.

But what role do streamers play in this equation? Have Ritchie's earnings been substantial after these two films? Streamers have capitalised on Ritchie's evolution, particularly in 2023, as both films catered to the action-hungry audiences of Netflix and Amazon. Despite the box office disappointment, Netflix released "Operation Fortune" on Netflix in April, garnering 2.5M streams and top 9. Just two months later, Amazon Prime premiered "The Covenant", reaching the top 2 with 2.2M streams. In Spain, the film ranked within the top 10 with 1.1M streams, but in France, it only reached the top 32 with 533K streams. The film failed to generate interest in Italy and Germany, although according to our checks, the film is Seven" and "Fame."

In a world driven by existing IPs, could there ever be another "Snatch"?





#### THE ENTRY OF GOOD WEATHER **BRINGS BAD NEWS TO THE MARKET**

Over the past two months, the German market has also experienced a decline in cumulative streams within the Top 100 as the other markets. While the peak of consumption occurs in December reaching 75 million streams, as we have observed both in the previous year and across other markets, the summer season makes the Top 100 struggle to reach 40 million streams in the month of June. This marks the lowest recorded month for the German market. This performance places this month Germany as the second smallest market, trailing behind Italy.

#### EUROPEAN ACTION MOVIES TAKE **SPACE WITH ALMOST 7M VIEWS**

Similar to trends observed in other markets, the Action genre has dominated the scene this month, claiming 8 out of the Top 10 mostwatched movies. While a majority of these films originate from the United States, still over 40% of the streams are attributed to European content (including UK, local, and European productions). This surge can be largely attributed to titles such as "Extraction 2," "No Time To Die", and "Blood and Gold."






#### **CZECH AND SPANISH FILMS STAND** OUT THIS MONTH

A significant portion of this decline of streams in all markets, can be attributed to American and Canadian productions. This month, they have only managed to secure a 48% share of the total, experiencing a loss of up to 5 million streams. In contrast, European productions have gained more traction this month, with notable contributions from Czech and Spanish films. Czech productions "Extraction 2" and "Unlocked" have stood out, along with Spanish titles such as "Tin & Tina," "Culpa Mía," "A través del mar", "Through My Window" and "Sweet Home."


#### **"BLOOD** AND GOLD" **GERMANY GREAT AGAIN**

"Blood and Gold" has garnered an impressive 8.6M streams, ranking as the 9th most-played movie since its premiere in April, representing a successful venture from the European continent. This movie is one of the local stars in the 2023 productions, establishing a strong presence in Europe, echoing the success of "All Quiet On The Western Front." Having maintained its position in the Top #10 global non-English movies for four consecutive weeks in Netflix Official Top, "Blood and Gold" amassed a remarkable 25M hours of viewership within its second week of release.




#### PRIME BREAKS NEW THANKS TO ACTION AND SPANISH SENSATION "CULPA MÍA"

Amazon Prime achieves a remarkable milestone by setting a new record for market share in the German entertainment landscape, commanding an impressive 30% of the total. It's somewhat ironic that this recordbreaking feat coincides with the inclusion of Disney+ in Think Data's analysis. Germany has consistently proven to be a fertile ground for Amazon's success, but securing this share is undeniably a pivotal moment.

This achievement can be attributed to the resurgence of the Action genre, leading to the removal of "No Time To Die" and "SAS: Red Notice" from the library, alongside the highly anticipated Spanish premiere of "Culpa Mía".

In contrast, Netflix maintains its stronghold with a 67.6% share, while Disney+ accounts for a 2.04% share. It's evident that Disney+ hasn't penetrated the German market as deeply as it has in other regions. On average, throughout this month of June, Disney+ has garnered a 9.6% share across all markets, with Germany representing the market with the lowest share and Italy standing as the leader with an 18.45% share.




#### **CATALOG SHARE BY COUNTRY**

#### WHAT ACTION LOST, ANIMATION FOUND




#### AMERICAN CANADIAN AN 8 DOMINANCE



The German market is currently experiencing a phase of contraction, probably because of the start of the summer, positioning itself as the smallest market this month for series, trailing behind Italy and Spain.











#### AMAZON PRODUCTIONS FINALLY **RULED THE EUROPEAN CHARTS**

The standout local production this month hails from Amazon, titled "Der Gryphon". As extensively detailed in a feature by Deadline, which incorporates insights from Philip Pratt, the executive overseeing the original series at Amazon Prime Video, this series is hailed as "the most significant German fantasy project since The NeverEnding Story". Drawing inspiration from the literary works of fantasy novelist Wolfgang Hohlbein, the source material has achieved an impressive global sales record of over 40M copies spanning four decades. The question arises: Will it ever replicate these numbers within the realm of streaming?

Two additional Amazon productions have also managed to secure positions on this month's charts. In "Joko Winterscheidt Presents: The World's Most Dangerous Show", renowned actor Joko Winterscheidt (recognised for "Look Who's Back") embarks on an extensive exploration of the imminent climate catastrophe, delving into innovative strategies to combat it. Furthermore, "LOL: Last One Laughing", having recently added a substantial 1.1M views, now boasts 28 million views since its debut in April. This firmly cements its status as the most popular season thus far in the local edition.







#### NOTHING NEW UNDER THE WAR **STREAMING SUN**

There hasn't been a significant change since the last report; in fact, the competitive landscape remains relatively consistent.


Netflix continues to hold a dominant share of 72% in terms of streaming distribution, asserting control over key genres: Comedy (80.8 million views), Drama (49.7 million views), and Action (35.8 million views).

Disney+ maintains a 12% share, while Amazon captures 16%. Disney+ achieves notable success in the Family & Kids and Comedy genres, whereas Amazon excels in the Comedy and Action genres.









### HOT CONTENT IN GERMANY 'BLOOD & GOLD': A TOP-CHARTIN GERMAN BLEND OF 'INGLOURIOUS BASTERDS', Indiana Jones, and Spaghetti Western

German director Peter Thorwarth ("Blood Red Sky", "The Wave") teams up once again with Netflix to deliver an audience-pleasing (at least for those who can endure high doses of violence and blood) idiosyncratic neo-spaghetti Western that's reminiscent of both "Inglourious Basterds" and "Indiana Jones", with a dash of Tarantino. This film, often described as a "currywurst western," has garnered over 8.6M streams across the five territories t since its release on May 26th.

The film's narrative revolves around a German soldier who deserts his post during the waning days of World War II to reclaim a life with his family. He's never believed in the war, and this disbelief persists. After a merciless squad of SS troops apprehends him, he's hanged for treason and left for dead. But after a stranger rescues him, the Nazis find themselves on the receiving end of his retribution.

The concoction of villainous Nazis seeking a hidden treasure, combined with a blend of action, satire, and thought-provoking commentary, may sound familiar to fans of the "Indiana Jones" saga. However, let's be frank: these elements aren't exclusive to George Lucas' franchise. What's intriguing is that Netflix chose to release "Blood & Gold" just a month before the latest instalment of the fedora-wearing hero graced cinemas. During a period when indie enthusiasts have been indulging in previous chapters on Disney+—according to FlixPatrol, the films have consistently ranked in the Top 10 in over 20 countries—the timing of "Blood & Gold" might be part of a meticulously crafted content strategy from Los Gatos. This strategy seems tailored to engage fans of the saga and provide them with analogous content.

The film features German actors Alexander Scheer ("Blood Red Sky"), Robert Maaser ("1917"), Florian Schmidtke ("Blood Red Sky"), and Marie Hacke ("Bauhaus"). Behind this production is Rat Pack Filmproduktion, the same production company responsible for hits like "The Revenant" and Thorwarth's directorial debut "The Wave." This film sets out to deliver a pulpy World War II revenge escapade.

In June, "Blood & Gold" ascended to the top of the charts, accumulating over 8.6M streams. It secured the 9th position in the most-played movie list since its May premiere. During June, 'Blood & Gold' claimed the top spot on the European charts, particularly in Germany and France, where it ranked 5th with 1.18M streams and 12th with 1M, respectively. This outcome underscores the fusion of action and dark humour successfully resonates with European audiences. # **GLOBAL TAKES**

- 1 / Amazon Prime Video share rates are soaring. Amazon's recent success in reclaiming its previous share percentages is a testament to the platform's strength in the streaming arena. Despite the entry of Disney+ and HBO Max into the market, Amazon Prime has managed to secure an impressive 20.5% share in movies, an impressive feat of +4 points compared to the previous month. One factor that contributed to this success is the exceptionally favourable month that Amazon Prime had. "Culpa Mía" and "Medellin" originals claimed the top in the markets. However, local acquisitions conquered good marks to keep the platform rates soaring. This is a significant victory for Prime Video, which has often struggled to secure top titles and maintain its share. In fact, Amazon Prime has set a new record for market share in the German market, commanding an impressive 30% of the total.
- 6 / Catalan productions fire the Spanish audience. "Cites" has become the most-watched series on Amazon, with an impressive 3.6 million streams this month. It's becoming regular to spot Catalan productions hitting the charts such as "Merlí" and "Smiley" . Additionally, "A través del Mar" does a wonderful job of capturing the beautiful ambience of the Costa Brava at the doors of summer. It's no surprise that the original film was such a success, and it's great to see that the streaming giant is continuing to invest in the success of this IP.
- **Disney+ leads Italian's show consumption.** Disney+ 5/ rules the series chart as runner-up in the Italian market with a commanding share of almost 38% of the total streams, propelling the American content thanks to TV smash "How I Met Your Mother", "Grey's Anatomy", kids phenomenon "Bluey" and evergreen "The Simpson" in the Top7.

2 / Amazon Prime Video is taking a page out of **Netflix's book** by focusing on YA romantic content with their recent strategy. "Culpa Mía" follows a similar formula to successful Netflix shows like "Through the Window", "Purple Hearts", "The Royal Treatment", "The Girl Allergic to Wifi", and "The Kissing Booth". Spain hit a new record in YA content binge-watching with romantic productions collecting fans across social media, and having "Valeria" final season as the cherry on the cake.

3 / Italian comedy remains the most popular genre. This month, Italian comedy has reached 6 million streams, proving its continued dominance in the market. It's no surprise that comedy has always been important in Italy's entertainment industry, but what's truly remarkable is its consistent growth. 7 / Animation Revival and Its Impact: The animation genre is experiencing a remarkable revival in European markets, reasserting its position as a significant player in the streaming catalogues. In France, Animation has made a wicked comeback, securing 14% of the viewership pie. Spain follows a similar trend; the genre has emerged as a strong contender, accounting for 13.2% share and fiercely competing with ever-present popular Drama content. Notable series such as "Rick and Morty" on Netflix and "The Simpsons" on Disney+ captivated the adult segment. Germany's Animation records doubled its previous month's performance, reaching nearly 16%
